How do I properly get rid of these?



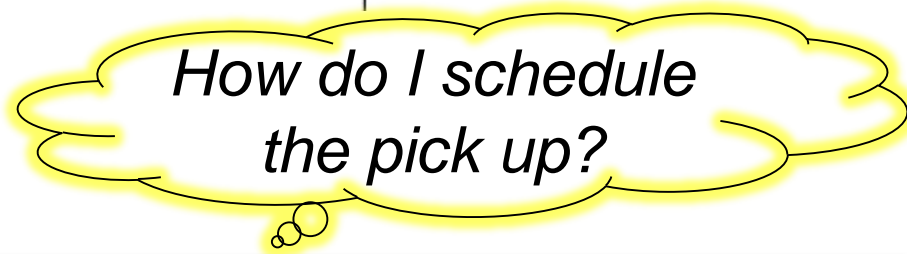
3 Easy Steps

1. Close container - *Do Not Tape !*
2. Completely fill out and apply label

Print and attach to black bin before removal, example below
